installing and removal of Flexi360 Guide Posts.

**SCOPE** The scope of work covers manually installing and removal of - Flexi360 Guide

Posts into the ground using the Roadside Products recommended installation tools .

**BEFORE** The approved equipment for installing this type of post is the FPD1700

**YOU BEGIN** – Flexi360 Manual driver. *Refer to Diagrams*

While Installing Posts on the roadside, Roadside Products recommends facing the oncoming traffic and the following instructions are based on that position.

Remove slide retaining clip from driver body



Turn Driver upside down and remove R clip. Slide picket foot into driver.



Insert retaining clip into the driver



Manouvere the picket and Driver into the installation position



Now using two hands , drive the picket  $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) \left( 1\right)$ 



Drive picket to ground level




Remove retaining clip



Remove driver from picket



Install post onto picket



Using the supplied crimping tool crimp the end tag on the acceptor plate



Installation complete



Using the supplied crimping tool uncrimp the end tag on the acceptor plate




Remove post from picket foot











Replace the retaining clip



Now using two hands, remove the picket



Remove retaining clip



Remove driver from picket
